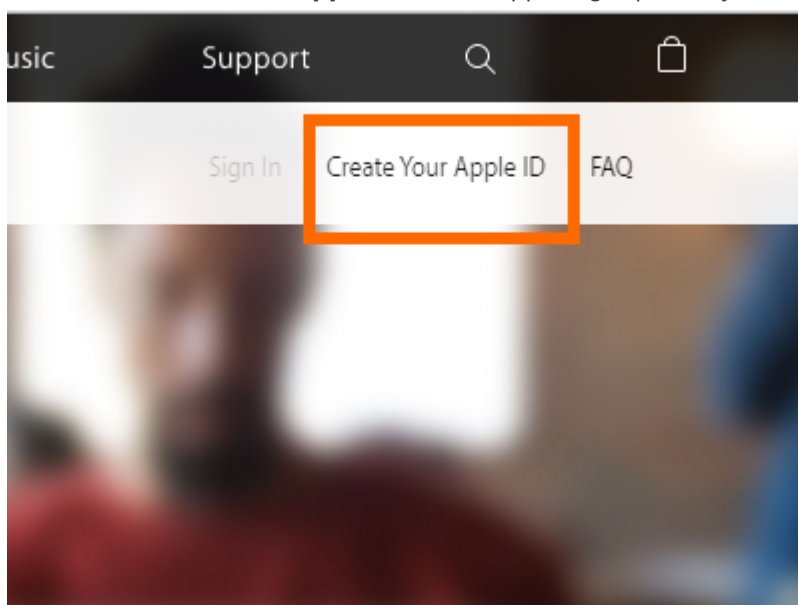

Create a New Apple ID Using a Computer

To create your new Apple ID using your PC, follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://appleid.apple.com>

2. Click on **Create Your Apple ID** on the upper-right part of your computer's screen.



3. On the Create Your Apple ID Page, **enter your @health.fau.edu email address for FAU issued devices**. This will be used as your Apple ID.

4. Enter and confirm your **password**. Passwords should be at least eight characters, have at least one number, and have a lowercase and an uppercase letter.

5. Input your **name and birthday**.

6. Enter three **security questions** with three different security answers.

8. Follow the prompts to complete the initial creation.

9. **IMPORTANT:** Apple will send a **confirmation email** containing a code to your registered email address.
